*Please **DO NOT** leave donations on porches, ramps, or by doors of county buildings.



- 1- 14oz. can sweetened condensed

<u>Jelly Bean Fudge</u>

- milk
- 1 tsp vanilla extract
- 1 cup jelly beans

Directions: Place chocolate chips in a microwavable bowl. Melt in 30 sec. intervals, stirring between until fully melted and smooth. Stir in sweetened condensed milk and vanilla extract. Fold in jelly beans. Spread into a greased 8x8 baking dish. Refrigerate until set. Cut into small squares and store in an airtight container in freezer until serving. www.freshlyhomecooked.com
